

Fairdale Alumni Association
Minutes of Regular Meeting
August 16, 2007

The regular meeting of the Fairdale Alumni Association was held on August 16, 2007 in the alumni room of Fairdale High School. A quorum being present, the meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by President Linda Ray.

The **minutes** of the June 21, 2007 meeting were approved as read. There was no meeting held in July.

Diane Edwards presented the **Treasurer's report**. Operating funds are \$4,598, endowment fund \$1,500 and stadium funds \$20,655. The alumni received a \$2,500 donation with the stipulation that it be used for the softball field.

Stadium Report:

- Flynn Brothers has paved the tennis courts.
- Ernest Smith, Chris Johnstone and Brad Weston spread gravel on the track. It is scheduled to be rubberized tomorrow.
- Jones Electric is putting lights under bleachers.
- Dixie Plumbing (Danny Churchman) has refurbished the bathrooms. Chris Johnstone, Brad Weston and Ron Weston painted the bathroom floor.
- Specialty Masonry Perma Stone donated cultured stone for donor wall. Names were sent today for donor plates.
- Hometown Sanitation donated ten large trash cans.
- Jones Ornamental Iron (Forrest and Herschel Jones) will design the new gates – a large one and a small pedestrian turnstile type. They will donate labor with the alumni paying for materials.
- Volunteer alumni will meet at 6:00 p.m. next Thursday to landscape the triangle area in front of the donor wall. Rick Johnstone will supply the mulch.
- Vickie Welch, Steve Clark and Ron Weston are in discussion with Mike Heitz of Metro Parks about a grant to be used for two additional tennis courts so matches can be held on FHS campus.

Unfinished Business:

- Dues notices were prepared and mailed by Diane Edwards. There has been a good return thus far.

New Business:

- Pam Hicks reported that she has workers scheduled for the alumni booth.
- Linda Ray said we have plenty of items on hand to give away and/or sell at our booth.
- **Motion** made by Andy Weston, seconded and carried to sell alumni patches for \$4 with the exception that someone joining the alumni association will receive a complimentary patch.
- Andy Weston will drive his mustang convertible in the parade and Jason Ray will wear the bulldog mascot costume.
