Minutes of Regular Meeting
October 20, 2005

President Linda Ray called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes of September 15, 2005 were approved as read.

Diane Edwards presented the Treasurer's report. Income from the Fairdale Fair booth was \$644. The endowment fund totals \$800. Available funds are \$5,439. **Annual dues** for 2005/2006 are now due.

Linda Ray reported that Rose (Allison) Hibbs from the class of '68 has volunteered to help maintain our **web site**. Meeting minutes will be emailed to Ms. Hibbs for web publication. Linda Ray has class info for 1966 and 1967. Roberta Cardy gave Linda class info for 1931 thru 1951. This info will be given to Rose Hibbs for the web site database.

Linda Ray mailed completed **501 c3** form to the IRS.

Linda Ray reported on the sizes, types and prices of available **alumni patches**. The consensus was to consider purchasing 200 three inch, iron on, 100% embroidery patches with the FHS crest at an approximate cost of \$1.35 each. Andy Weston will facilitate.

Linda Duncan, retired FHS principal, stated her intention to campaign for **election to the school board**. She distributed her biography and expressed her qualifications and reasons for wanting to serve on the board.

The alumni will have a table at the **Fairdale Community Club Halloween party** on October 25 at 6:00 p.m. at the Fairdale Playtorium. We will hand out candy, stickers and alumni information.

The alumni will be in charge of the hospitality room for the **King of the Bluegrass** basketball tournament again this year. The tournament runs from Thursday, December 15 through Tuesday, December 20. No games on Sunday. In early November, Pam and Dottie Hicks will mail letters requesting donations to businesses. The list of individual donors needs to be reviewed and updated. Mount Holly Methodist Church, Fairdale Baptist Church, PTSA and Faculty, Basketball and Cheerleader Parents and the alumni will each host an evening during the tournament. Andy and Sharon Weston are donating a microwave for use in the hospitality room.
